



- Students access Charger Connection through myCharger (login required).



They can also display emergency alerts and info.



# Communicating with **EVERYONE**

Students are <u>automatically enrolled</u> in the **emergency notification system**.

Family members can **choose to sign up** to receive emergency alerts, which can be delivered by phone, text, and/or email.



#### Emergency Notification System: Sign Up and Keep Your Info Current

If a situation arises, either on or off campus, that in the judgment of the Chief of Police at the University of New Haven constitutes an ongoing or continuing threat, or if severe weather conditions exist, an Alert will be issued via the University's Emergency Notification System

The system sends messages wa text, email and voice. The University strongly encourages students, faculty, staff and parents to make sure their emergency contact information is current.
