Pre-Medical Studies

- **Open to all majors**
- Adds medical school pre-requisites to degree audit
- Required for composite letter from Composite Letter Committee for medical school application
- Apply after completing 15 credits at University of New Haven with a **minimum 3.5 cumulative GPA and a 3.3 science GPA or higher**. Must maintain the GPA standards throughout their coursework.
- Advising through HPAC:
 - MCAT Prep, Medical School Interviewing, Personal Statement Writing, Application Preparation, etc.
